Dr. Farrell also reported that our three year lease for the laptops has expired. We looked into the notebook laptops which have a solid state hard drive and a warranty which will cover the full four years. We will be getting notebook laptops and will issue one to each student in grades 9 through 12. The student will be able to purchase it at the end of school or return it.

Terry Damon gave the board an update on the progress of the lobby area of the high school. The library slate roof has some material behind it that will need abatement. Some of it needs to be removed with the work that is currently being done so we might as well remove the rest of the asbestos. There will be a change order for this.
